HOT design idea

Standing in Glenn Billington's hallway, there's an unusual piece of artwork on display. But all is not as it seems, as Charlotte Hart discovers.

hen Glenn Billington moved into his Sutton town centre apartment, little did he know that it would lead to a new business venture with his family. Having retired from West Midlands Police in 2007, the 58-year-old moved to Spain with wife Yvonne where they lived for a few years.

Drawn back to Sutton Coldfield, the couple now divide their time between the Royal town and the more sunnier climes of Spain. Needing to carry out some renovations, the couple took to changing the décor of their new home, adding their own style stamp. And it soon became apparent the old storage heaters would need replacing because they looked ugly, were bulky and cumbersome. Living in an apartment, however, that only supplied electric heating meant his choices were limited. And it was this initial problem that has paved the way for a whole new challenge for Glenn and his family. His 37-year-old son Matt explains: "Rather than just wanting to update the same storage heater for another, my father wanted something more efficient. He therefore sourced his own infrared heaters and then had to find someone else to fit them. "His neighbour Peter also had the same issue."
